By the Will of God. Amen,

Considering the shortness of life and the certainty of death, whilst being yet in a sound state of mind, I Archibald Fraser, of M. Lellan's Mountain, County of Hictou, and Province of Nova Scotia, make this my last Will and testament.

1st I bequeath my body to the grave and my Soul to the free mercies of our Saviour Jesus Christ.

2nd I devise and bequeath the farm on which I presently live, with all the buildings and improvements that shall be on it at the time of my death to my beloved wife Eliza Fraser, without any conditions on her part,

3rd I devise and bequeath all the personal property, goods and chattles of which I shall be possessed at the time of my death to my wife, with full power to use it according to her best judgment.

4th I devise that Hugh my son shall be sent to a trade, whichever trade he chooses, and that suitable clothing shall be provided for him till he acquires his trade.

5th I devise that I shall receive a decent Christian burial, and that all my lawful debts shall be paid.

6th I devise that William Ross and Thomas Holmes my sons in law shall be executors of my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all other testamentary witnesses. In witness whereof I have hereto set my hand and seal.
