In the name of God, so let it be.

I Charles Fraser of Fisher's Grant in the County of Pictou
Province of Nova Scotia, being weak in body, and
knowing that Life is uncertain, Do make and
ordain this my last Will and Testament: That
after payment of my just and legal Debts I hereby
devise and bequeath to my son Samuel Fraser
that rear part of the farm on which I now reside,
being from the west corner of the lands of Carnal
Mr. Arthur running South westerly to the lines of the
lands of William Harris thence along W^m Harris's
line to the lands of one W^m Cantley, thence north
easterly to the lands of Carnal Mr. Shattuck aforesaid,
thence north westerly to the place of beginning.
And I devise and bequeath to my son James Fraser
all the rest or front part of the farm on which I
now reside, bounded on the north by the road
leading to lands now owned by W^m Christie on the
south or rear by the lands of Carnal Mr. Arthur
on the East by the lands of A. W. James and
on the West by the lands of W^m Harris with all
the buildings thereon and Horses Cattle and Sheep
and all the personal property of whatever kind
that I may own at my death after payment of
my Debts.

And I hereby nominate and appoint
Smith Foster and M. G. Sproull both of Fisher's
Grant my Executors and administrators of this
my last Will and Testament.

In witness whereof I have hereunto

Grant this 22^d day of September in the year of
our Lord 1894.
