I David Fraser of Westville in the  
County of Pitkin Bencham do hereby  
revok all former wills and Testaments  
dispositions made by me and declare  
this to be my last will and Testament  
I appoint James M. Kirk of  
Westville in the County of Pitkin  
Micheal and Alexander K. Senter  
of the same Place Executors to be the  
Executors and Trustees of this my  
Last will

I give and bequeath to my daughter  
Mary Ann the wife of Robert H.  
McKay the dwelling house in which  
we now live and the lot and  
premises in connection therewith  
as previously laid off together with  
all the household furniture now therein  
but this on condition that she  
pay my son James the sum of  
Two thousand Dollars

I give and bequeath to my son James  
I give and bequeath the sum of  
Three thousand and fifty Dollars  
to be paid out of my life insurance  
policy but which sum I direct  
my Executors to pay to George  
McDonald to discharge any  
indebtedness which may then be  
owing to him by my son James  
or myself. I also give and bequeath  
to my son James the further sum

of two hundred and fifty Dollars to  
be paid out of my life insurance  
policy but which I shall my  
executors to place to the credit of my  
daughter Jessie Coover in the  
Wells Bank. The same to be a  
part of the sum borrowed by  
her from my said Grandfather  
Jessie Coover.

I give and bequeath to my Grand  
children Louella Flann and Thomas  
Flann the sum of fifty Dollars  
each which several sums I  
want to be paid out of my life  
insurance and to be deposited at  
interest for them in some reliable  
Bank and to be paid them when  
they shall have attained the age  
of twenty one years. To my Grand  
son Edward M. Ray I give my  
daughter Miffie I bequeath the  
sum of fifty Dollars to be  
deposited and paid out in the  
Bank above set forth. To my  
Granddaughter Jessie Coover I give  
and bequeath the sum of one hundred  
Dollars to be paid out of my life  
insurance and to be deposited  
in the Bank above set forth. I also  
and I request that she shall have  
a home provided for her so long  
as she shall need or desire it up to

The time of the arrival of the age of  
 twenty one years, the said sum  
 of one hundred & 50 shillings I direct  
 to be apportioned and paid out in the  
 same manner and times as I  
 have already directed to be done in  
 respect to my other grand children  
 Provided always that if any of  
 my said grand children shall die  
 before they reach the age of twenty  
 one years, leaving no issue then  
 the sum of money hereby granted  
 is to revert to their parents; if  
 parents dead then to their next  
 of kin

To my son John & Isaac I give  
 and bequeath all the part of my  
 real and personal property of whatever  
 nature and whatsoever situated
