their heirs forever, if one of my
daughters dies before the other
the one that lives will have all
the real estate

3^d I do nominate and appoint my
brother in law Alexander M. Donald
of Blairgowrie and my sister Annice
of the Lallans Widdow as executors
of of this my last will and
Testament, my daughter is to
live with Annice my sister who
is to take care of them but if
she gets unable or neglects or
refuses to take care of them

then my brother in law Alexander
McDonald the other executor will
take them to his own home and
take care of them, the executor
is to look over all the personal
property and take care of it and
to use it if needed for the support
of the family
