I direct my Executor hereinafter named to pay all my just debts funeral and other expenses and the expenses attendant upon the settlement of my estate as soon as conveniently may be after my decease, and out of the sums remaining to pay the legacies hereinafter mentioned.

To her also I give and bequeath all my house and hold furniture and the personal effects that are in the house upon said lot.

I give and bequeath all the residue and remainder of my estate in equal shares to my sister Barbara Ferguson, to my brother James R. Cullton and to my niece Christy Mitchell wife of Alexander Mitchell of Stillarton aforesaid.

I nominate and appoint my friend James Ross Superintendent of Streets in said New Glasgow, Executor of this my

Last Will and Testament.
