I James Treasor of Pictou in the County of Pictou Grocer, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and bearing in mind the certainty of death but the uncertain time thereof, do make publick and declare this my last Will and Testament as follows viz -

First, I will and direct that all my just debts Funeral expenses and the expenses attending the settlement of my Estate be paid by my executors and Executors out of the personal property left by me at the time of my decease.

Second, I give devise and bequeath all my Real Estate and all the rest and residue of my personal property including moneys, notes of bank, Book accounts Goods Chattels and effects of whatsoever nature and wheresoever the same may be, that may belong to me at the time of my decease to my beloved wife Margaret for her sole and absolute use and to be disposed of by her in which ever way she may think proper.

Third, I hereby nominate and appoint Mr. Joseph A. Gordon of Pictou aforesaid Merchant, and my beloved wife Margaret Treasor, Executor and executrix of this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking and disannulling all other Wills by me at any time heretofore made and declaring this to be my last Will and Testament.
