This is the last Will and Testament of John
Andrew Frazer of New Glasgow Elder

I give and bequeath to James Church the
sum of One Hundred dollars to be divided by the
Session as follows, To the Foreign Missions Thirty
dollars, to the Home Missions Twenty dollars, Thirty
Dollars towards payment of the debt on the Church
and twenty dollars to the poor of the congregation,
and I hereby authorize the same to be paid within
Six months from this date by my friend A. C. Frazer
whom I will place in funds for that purpose.

I give devise and bequeath to my son
James W. all my real Estate on Condition that he
pay Two Hundred Dollars to my Daughters Mary
Ann and Carrie one hundred dollars to each,

I give and devise to each of my three sons
Andrew, ^{Daniel} and Simon Hugh, one hundred Dollars
each,

All the remainders of my estate after payment
of the sums hereinbefore mentioned reserving
after payment of my just debts and funeral expenses

I give and bequeath to my two daughters Mary
Ann and Caroline share and share alike,

I order that all my furniture and Effects
in the house shall be divided between my son
James W. and my daughters Mary Ann and
Caroline as they shall agree.

I appoint as my executors James
William my son and Thomas Jackson my
son in law.
