This is the last Will and Testament of
Thomas Tracer of Quarry Hill Tracer's Mountain
farmer.

1. I give devise and bequeath to my son Hugh Simon
all my real and personal property of every kind
and description subject to the conditions following.
2. I give to Ellen Tracer my housekeeper fifteen
acres of land to be by her held during her life
time, then to be the property of my said son
Hugh Simon, the said land to be lot off between
the Eastern extension Railway and the Rear
of my land on the western side of my said land.
If the said fifteen acres should include my
house then my son Hugh Simon shall in equality
with the said Ellen Tracer, if not then she shall
have a right to the use of my said house equally
with my said son Hugh Simon, I also bequeath
to the said Ellen Tracer one Cow and three sheep
and the sum of One Hundred Dollars in Cash,
to be given and paid her by my said son Hugh
Simon.
3. If my daughter Ellen Ann shall live or come, she
is to have a Cow and three sheep and her clothing,
should she not recover from her present illness -
she is nevertheless to be provided with clothing
as heretofore by my said son Hugh Simon.
4. My said son Hugh Simon shall provide for
his mother during her lifetime in all respects
as she has heretofore been provided for by me.
5. I give and devise to my three sons John James,
Daniel Robert, and William Frederick the sum of
Twenty dollars each.
