North Dakota being in good bodily

mind and memory Calling to mind
the frailty of human life and being
desirous of settling my worldly
affairs and directing how the estate
with which it hath pleased God to
bless me shall be disposed of after
my decease while I have strength and
capacity so to do make and publish
this my last will and Testament
hereby revoking and making null
and void all other wills and Testaments
by me heretofore made, and first
I Commend my immortal being to Him
who gave it and my body to earth to
be buried with little expense or
ostentation by my Executors hereinafter
named. And as to my worldly
estate and all the property real and
personal or mixed of which I shall
die Seized and possessed or to
which I shall be entitled at the
time of my decease I devise
bequeath and dispose thereof in the
manner following to wit,

I give and bequeath to my Grand-
child Janet Hudson fifty Dollars
in Cash

I give and bequeath my children
Catherine Ann Hudson, James Henry
Fraser, Donald Robert Fraser
William Seward Fraser, Neil Fraser
Fraser and Samuel Gordon Fraser
the sum of five Dollars each

All the rest and residue of my
estate real and personal or mixed
of which I shall die seized or
possessed or to which I shall be
entitled at the time of my decease
I give devise and bequeath to my
son John Thomas Fraser first
above mentioned

Lastly I do recommend and appoint
Daniel Ross and John Thomas
Fraser both of Lanesboro to be the
Executors of this my last will
and Testament
