mind and memory do make and publish this
my last Will and Testament as follows.

- Secondly - I give and bequeath to the Rev. James W.
Fraser my nephew the rest of my Real property
he to take possession at the decease of both my
self and wife.
- Thirdly - I give and bequeath to Jessie my beloved
wife, if she survives me all my personal property
including household furniture, stock, Farming
Utensils, waggons &c. Credits, monies, in one word
all my personal property.
- Fourthly - I ordain and appoint James M. May Mill Bros &
and John Fraser A. son, my nephew my Executors to
this my last Will and Testament.
