And as regards my property I give and dispose of the same in the following manner:

First. I give and devise to Elizabeth Mary Fraser my wife one House and Lot No 38 on South 8th Street.

Secondly. One Hundred and fifty acres more or less in the Fish Post Farm, on Cash River Piute County, Nevada.

Thirdly. Also all the personal property that I may be owner of at my Death.

I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Elizabeth Mary Fraser Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, the executrix is not required to give Bonds, written with my own hand and accord this 26th day of January 1892.
