I give devise and bequeath forty Dollars
To my daughter W Evelyn Gordon I
give devise and bequeath forty Dollars
To my son Martin Henry Gordon I
give devise and bequeath all my
real estate and personal property of
whatever nature and kind remaining at
my death after the debts
mentioned by me here

It is my will that my said
daughters Sarah Jane Gordon
and W Evelyn Gordon have
a free house on the hundred
with my son Martin Henry
Gordon so long as they require it
I hereby nominate and
appoint my friend Robert Stewart
Stewart agent of Glenora in
the said County of Peter to be
executor of this my last will
and Testament and do declare

then to be my Clerk with and Personnel
Henry C. O'Steen and accumulating all
former ones
