property to be sold and proceeds divided

both in the County of Oneida

I hereby direct my executor to sell a  
piece of land containing of more or  
less which I own situate at the east  
end of the Town of Westville on the north

Presbyterian Church in Canada one  
hundred Dollars

To my husband Edward Graham  
one hundred Dollars

To my brother Daniel Collier twenty dollars  
To my brother Anthony Collier twenty dollars  
To my sister Anne Collier wife of my brother

To my sister Elizabeth Kirtland of Hardwood  
Ohio twenty dollars

To Anne Graham daughter of William  
Graham Westcott ten dollars

In the event of the sale of the piece of  
land aforesaid not realizing enough to pay  
the legacies and the expenses incidental  
to probating my will then the legacies  
shall be paid in the proportions above  
stated out of the money available

I desire to state that it is my wish  
to be interred in a casket & casket  
Westcott and I hereby instruct my  
executor to pay all my just debts  
and funeral expenses as soon as  
possible after my decease and to see  
to it that the lot where I am buried  
is properly cared for and a tablet  
erected to mark my passing place
