do make and publish this my last Will and
Testament -

Graham, all that parcel of land now owned by
me, and bounded by the lands of my father,
Alexander Graham, the land of my brother Alex-
ander Graham, and the land of my Uncle Donald
Graham, containing one hundred acres more or
less ~~with~~ to have and to hold the same to him;
and his heirs and assigns forever, with this burden,
and condition, namely, that he help his father,
Alexander Graham, as I have endeavoured to do,
when my health permitted me.

Graham, as Executor of this my last Will -
