I, John Grant of Timmer's Mountain in the County of Pictou, and Province of Nova Scotia, being in good health of body and of sound mind, and memory and understanding, but considering the uncertainty of this transitory life, do make and publish this my last Will and testament, in manner and form following - To wit -

first - it is my will and I do order that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as convenient after my decease.

first, I give and bequeath to my wife all my real and personal property that I will be in possession of at my death as long as she remains a widow. But in the event of her getting married again, my will is that the said property go back to my four children namely Thomas, Alexander W., Mary C., and David Grant.

second, I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Margaret and Thomas G. Grant my son as the executors of this my last Will and testament.
