public and declare this my last will
and Testament hereby revoking all
former wills by me at any time
heretofore made.

1 I hereby constitute and appoint
American Heas of Upper the Spence
and John W. Deane of the Spence
to be executors of this my last
will hereunto my said
executors to pay all my just debts
and funeral expenses and the
charges hereunto given due of
my estate.

2 after the payment of my said
debts and funeral expenses I give
devise and bequeath all the
residue of my estate to my
beloved Sister Mary Belle Ross
and estate (dumvivi) of any
real estate which I may be possessed
of at the time of my death.
