Grant one third to my daughter  
Dinah Vidler Grant one third  
and to my daughter Minnie Mc  
McKinnon wife of Angus McKinnon  
one third in equal shares  
absolutely

I devise and bequeath to my  
deceased daughter Ellen Childers  
Louise of Barton and Graham  
Barton fifty dollars each to  
be paid out of my personal  
property

residue of my real and personal  
estate not herein mentioned  
absolutely.
