This is the last Will of Paul Grant of French River in the County of Pictou Province of Nova Scotia Terra Nova.

I the said Paul Grant being of sound and disposing mind do make and publish this my last Will as follows revoking all former Wills.

First I give devise and bequeath to my wife Mary Grant during the term of her natural life that lot of land situate at French River on which I now reside containing one hundred and fifty acres of land more or less, my said wife to have and to hold the same during her natural life, and at her death I will devise and bequeath the same with all the buildings thereon to my two daughters Mary Agnes Grant and Margaret Jane Grant and the survivors of them share and share alike and their heirs and assigns forever.

Second I give devise and bequeath to my said two daughters Mary Agnes and Margaret Jane their heirs and assigns share and share alike and the survivors of them all my personal property of what ever nature or description which shall remain after paying the expenses of my funeral and proving this my will and paying all my just and legal debts and all bequests hereafter made.

Third I give and bequeath to my sons James Hugh and George the sum of one dollar each.

I hereby nominate and appoint my said daughter Margaret Jane Grant and Isaac H. Fraser of French River Terra Nova as my executors and

executor of this my last Will and Testament.
