publish this to be my last will and testament

I direct that my eye entor and eye entor
be my heirs after my decease shall
convert all my Real Estate into Money
the same to be disposed of by them to the
best advantage either by public or private
Sale as they shall deem best or most
expedient and after payment of all debts
due by me and the expenses incidental
to my estate they shall divide the Remainder
of the proceeds into five equal parts to
be distributed as follows

One share to my beloved daughter
Helen S. wife of William F. Fraser
one and one half share to my beloved
daughter Walter J. Gunn, one and one
half share to my beloved daughter
Anna A. Gunn the remaining one share
to be divided as follows

One third of the remaining one share

one share to my beloved Grand daughter
Walter J. Gunn to be deposited at Bank
Chosen by the said executor and remaining
till her eighteenth birthday for her
own exclusive use and disposal
within one week of her eighteenth birthday
the same shall be paid over to the said
Walter J. Gunn by the terms of this my

last will and Testament, in the event of
her death before her eighteenth birthday
The said bequest shall descend to my
beloved daughters Walter J Quinn and
Anna A Quinn share and share alike

Further such that my executor and
executors hereafter named shall give
