I, William James Cum, Farmer of Black
Brook in the district of St. Mary's in the County of
Pictou, and Province of Nova Scotia, make this
my last Will, I give devise ^{and bequeath} my Estate and property,
real and personal, as follows, that is to say,
to my son Duncan Stewart Cum the sum of Four
dollars Dominion currency, To my son David Cum
Four dollars, To my daughters Grace Ann Cum, Jane
Cum, Catherine Amelia Cum, and Helen Catharine
Cum, a comfortable living while they may choose
to remain at home, and when they may leave the
home they ^{are} each to have, if they it one Cow. To my
son Daniel Cum all that certain tract or parcel
of land lying and being in the district and
County aforesaid and bounded as follows;
beginning at a point half way between the
South east and the South ^{west} corners of lands granted
to one Hugh McKenzie, thence to run South
fifty eight degrees west until it reaches the North
line of land granted to one Donald McKenzie,
thence north thirty two degrees west seventy rods,
or to the side line between aforesaid Donald McKenzie
and one William McKenzie, as originally granted,
thence eastwardly by said side line to South west
corner of lands granted to aforesaid Hugh Mc-
Kenzie, thence South thirty two degrees to the place of
beginning, containing one hundred acres more
or less. To my son Alexander George Cum, all
that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being
in the district and County aforesaid - and bounded
as follows, that is to say, beginning at a spruce tree
marking the South east angle of the lot of land
granted to the Hugh McKenzie aforesaid, thence
to run South fifty eight degrees west to the North

east corner of lands granted to Donald McKenzie
thence thirty two degrees west seventy rods or half way
to north west corner of said lot of land, thence north
fifty eight degrees east to a point half way to point
between the south east and the south west corners
of the land granted to the Hugh McKenzie and
thence to the place of beginning containing
one hundred acres more or less, also a lot
of land containing one hundred acres more
or less situate lying and being in the district
and County aforesaid and bounded as follows
Beginning at a spruce tree marked W. S. G.
standing at the south east angle of the lot of land
granted to the Hugh McKenzie aforesaid, thence
running north fifty eight degrees east forty chains
to a spruce tree marked W. S. G. thence north
thirty two degrees west along the western end of
Black Lake twenty five chains to a maple tree
marked W. S. G. thence south fifty eight degrees
west forty chains to a maple tree marked W. S. G.
on the rear line of lots of Donald McKenzie and
Hugh McKenzie aforesaid, thence south thirty
two degrees east on the said line twenty five
chains to the place of beginning together with
all and singular the house, barns, outhouses, saw
mill, horses, cattle, sheep, and farming implements
and Book accounts, after all the lawful debts
I now owe or may owe at the date of my decease
out of the Estate above bequeathed,

I appoint Joseph Cameron, Farmer,
of Cash River St. Mary's in the County of Pictou -
and James Gunn of the Cash river St. Mary's
in the County and Province aforesaid, and
James McKay of Cash River St. Mary's in the
County and Province aforesaid, Executors of
this my Will.

published and declared this instrument, as
my will, at Black Brook, in the district of
St. Mary's, in the County of Pictou, on the Twenty third
day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and eighty one.
